Reason and purpose, missions and goals of the IGHM Germany

- The „Interessengemeinschaft Historische Motoren Deutschland“ wants to care for, foster and represent the technical heritage and cultural history of the internal combustion engine, and when possible counteract on these historical machines being scrapped.
To do so, IGHM will act as follows:
- IGHM will liaise with surviving engine manufacturers, clubs, associations, authorities and institutions, in order to be involved in the preservation and promotion of historical combustion engines.
- IGHM will educate the general public, especially the younger generation, on historical combustion engines by organizing rallies, by publications in specialist and club magazines and by giving lectures.
- IGHM will unite and coordinate personal, local and regional initiatives involving historical combustion engines.
- IGHM will encourage and promote a lively contact and information exchange between its members, as well as mutual support by help and advice in any way.
- IGHM is a selfless organization, and has no primary economical goals.

Contributory arrangements of the IGHM

1. The annual contribution fee will be withdrawn from your bank - account by direct debit around the 15th of February each year, or at the beginning of the membership. The direct debit authorization is an integral part of the membership application overleaf.
2. Payment by direct debit is available for inhabitants of SEPA countries only. For non-SEPA countries, individual payment conditions will be agreed upon at the beginning of the membership.
3. If the direct debit for the annual contribution is unsuccessful or cancelled due to lack of funds in your account, shipment of the IGHM magazine will be postponed, and any possible collection costs will have to be paid by the member.
4. If a member should end his/her membership during a current year, no contribution will be refunded for the remaining period of that year.
5. If a membership begins on or before June 30., the full contribution for that year is payable. Memberships beginning between July 1. and December 31. only pay half of that.
Membership begins as soon as the first contribution is paid.
6. Former members can only then become a member again after any overdue payments are settled, and if a majority of the board agrees on him / her rejoining IGHM .
7. The annual membership fee will be determined at the annual membership meeting.
8. Cancellation of the membership has to be done in writing to the chairman by the 15. November of the respective year.

Services of the IGHM

- Our members will receive the IGHM magazine, which will be published 3 or 4 times a year.
